

Petition Gathering Instructions

1. No Constitutional Initiative Petition circulated for signature may be bundled with or attached to any other petition form.
2. State law prohibits distributing Constitutional Amendment Initiative Petition Forms with more than one petition per page. If you choose to print two petitions per page, you must cut the page into two separate petitions prior to soliciting petition signatures. Soliciting petition signatures with more than one petition per page is a misdemeanor. Personhood Florida cannot not process any petitions that have more than one petition per page.
3. Each Petition must include the following:
 - a. The voter's name.
 - b. The voter's residential street address (including city and county);
 - c. The voter's date of birth or voter registration number;
 - d. The voter's signature; and
 - e. The date the voter signed the petition, as recorded by the voter.

Instructions for Printing 2 Petitions Per Page

The Personhood Florida Constitutional Amendment Initiative Petition Form has been designed so that two petitions can be printed per page. This cuts printing costs in half and allows the cut petition to fit inside a church bulletin. Please note the following though:

State law prohibits distributing Constitutional Amendment Initiative Petition Forms with more than one petition per page. If you choose to print two petitions per page, you must cut the page into two separate petitions prior to soliciting petition signatures. Soliciting petition signatures with more than one petition per page is a misdemeanor. Consequently, Personhood Florida cannot distribute a copy of the petition with two petitions per page, even in PDF (electronic) form. Personhood Florida cannot not process any petitions that have more than one petition per page.

To print two petitions per page, do the following:

1. Print as many copies of page 2 as you wish to print of page 2 of this document. This will print the petition on the left side of the page(s).
2. Re-insert the paper into the printer and print the same number of page 3 of this document. (You may want to print one copy to test the procedure to make sure you have the paper inserted correctly to print page 3 on the right side of the page.
3. Cut the page in half to create two petitions. Remember that soliciting petition signatures in Florida with more than one petition per page is a misdemeanor.
4. If you plan to print more than 100 petitions, fill out the [Personhood FL Printer Exemption Form](#) and fax it back to Personhood Florida, so that we can send you a file with two petitions per page.

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PETITION FORM

All information on this form, including your signature, becomes a public record upon receipt by the Supervisor of Elections. Under Florida law, it is a first degree misdemeanor, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, Florida Statutes, to knowingly sign more than one petition for a candidate, minor political party, or an issue. [Section 104.185, Florida Statutes]
If all requested information on this form is not completed, the form will not be valid.

This amendment defines all human beings as persons under the constitution regardless of age, race, health function, condition of physical and/or mental dependency and/or disability.

ARTICLE OR SECTION BEING CREATED OR AMENDED: The Creation of Article 1, Section 28
FULL TEXT OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT:
SECTION 28. Person Defined.--
(a) The words "person" and "natural person" apply to all human beings, irrespective of age, race, health, function, condition of physical and/or mental dependency and/or disability, or method of reproduction, from the beginning of the biological development of that human being.
(b) This amendment shall take effect on the first day of the next regular legislative session occurring after voter approval of this amendment.
